Use the labels on the diagram to complete the sentences below.



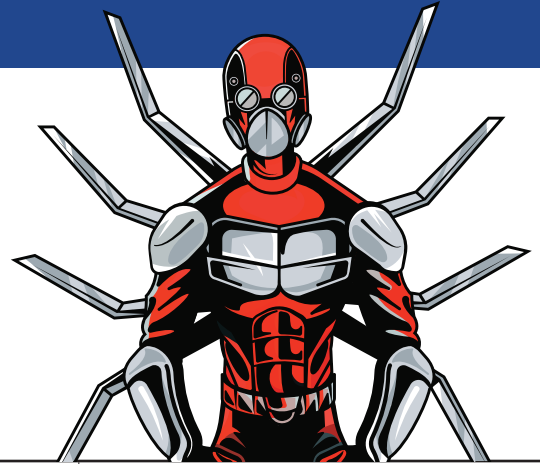
A desktop computer system includes a $\frac{\quad}{2}$ to display information and a $\frac{\quad}{4}$ that helps you put information into the computer. A computer $\frac{\quad}{1}$ helps you navigate information on the monitor. The $\frac{\quad}{5}$ produce sounds. The brain of the computer system, also called a $\frac{\quad}{5}$, tells the monitor and other computer parts what to do. The $\frac{\quad}{3}$ is a device that transfers text and picture information to paper.

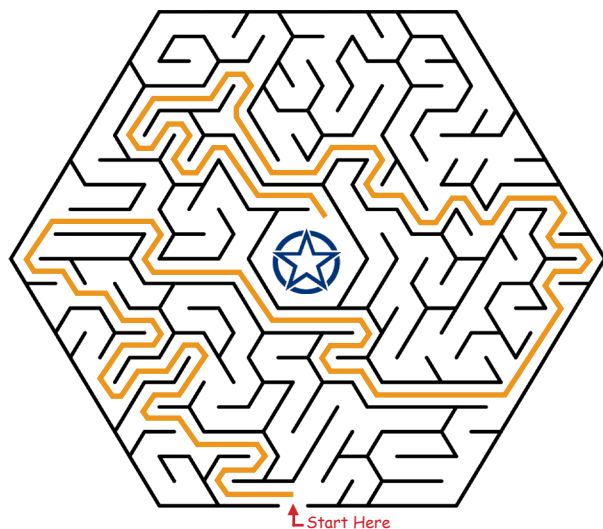
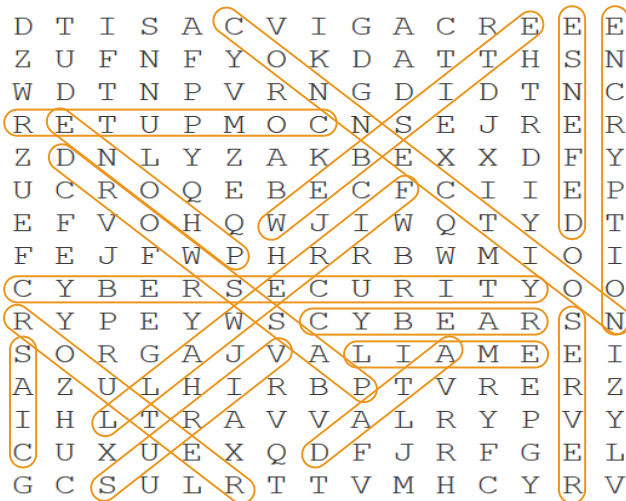
